ECACE Tuition Reporting for AY 21-22

- [Public Act 102-0174](#) requires the Early Childhood Access Consortium for Equity to report annually on tuition rates charged and net prices paid, reported both as including and excluding student loans, by enrolled members of the incumbent workforce.
- For AY 21-22, ECACE scholarship students can be used as a proxy for the incumbent workforce.
 - In future years, institutions cannot do this.
 - It is important that your institution finds a way to identify which students are part of the incumbent workforce.



ECACE Tuition Reporting for AY 21-22

- How we created the tuition reporting template:
 - Many, many hours of discussion with our reporting focus group (IBHE, ICCB, IDHS, ISAC)
 - Two-year and four-year institutional focus group
 - Additional feedback from select institutions from above focus group
 - IPEDS research
 - More revisions!

ECACE Tuition Reporting for AY 21-22

- “Full-time” and “half-time” are your institution’s enrollment statuses.
- We are asking for Fall and Spring data only (do not include Summer term).
- In-district rates should be used for community colleges.
- In-state rates should be used for four-year universities.
- Use IPEDS definitions for “[average net price](#)” and “[total cost of attendance](#)”
- You must answer all questions.
- You may need additional departments (financial aid, institutional research) to answer these questions.
